

Reciprocal Borrowing Contract Between Fort Frances Public Library And International Falls Public Library

The Board of Directors of the Public Library of Fort Frances, Ontario, Canada and the Board of Trustees of the Public Library of International Falls, Minnesota, U.S.A. agree to honor the borrower cards of the Fort Frances Public Library patrons and the International Falls Public Library patrons and permit the patrons to use each other's library for the purpose of reading and study in the libraries and for the borrowing of books and other materials that are available for home use.

It is understood the patron who borrows the material will be responsible for the return of the material to the lending library and accept the rules of the lending library as part of the condition of the loan.

It is agreed that the libraries will not be held responsible for materials lost by their patrons.

It is further agreed the libraries will cooperate and assist the lending library to recover all materials borrowed by their patrons whenever and however possible.

It is understood that Interlibrary loans are only available through the patron's home library.

Patrons residing outside Fort Frances town limits will need to show proof of payment to receive an active card in International Falls.

Termination shall take place under either of the following provisions:

Either Library Board giving notice to the other Board at least ninety (90) days prior to the date of termination;

or

By mutual agreement of the Boards.

This contract will become effective after ratification by the Library Boards of the Fort Frances Public Library and the International Falls Public Library, and signing by the Presidents and Secretaries of both Boards.
